Douglas Ry Wagner joined Agrinos in 2013 as Chief Technology Officer, assuming global responsibility for leadership of all scientific operations and continued development of Agrinos' robust High Yield Technology (HYT[®]) platform. Shortly thereafter Dr. Wagner also assumed commercial responsibility for several significant markets, leading the Agrinos businesses in the U.S. and Brazil. In 2014, he was appointed Chief Executive Officer by the Agrinos Board of Directors. Under Dr. Wagner's leadership Agrinos has continued to expand its position as a worldwide leader in developing novel biological solutions to improve crop yield, health and quality.

Dr. Wagner came to Agrinos from Dow AgroSciences, where he was Global New Ventures and Technology Leader. Before joining Dow, he spent 16 years in research and 10 years leading technology-driven start-up companies. Dr. Wagner spent three years as a researcher in the Division of Plant Industry, CSIRO, in Australia before joining the University of Oregon, where he was a Professor of Biology. He then transitioned to business, as both VP Plant Genetics and Biotechnology and Head of Exelixis Plant Sciences. Dr. Wagner is the author of over 30 scientific research publications and is an inventor with over 50 patents issued. He received a Bachelor of Science in Botany and Plant Pathology from Michigan State University and a Doctor of Philosophy in Genetics from the University of Washington.
